ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Kerb and Channelling along with a new footpath have been constructed on Nemies Road with new road line marking and splitter islands. There is also major work underway at the corner of Nemies and Perse Road with the realignment of the drain. This will create a safe environment for those residents walking to the local school and beyond.

Maynard Place parking in conjunction with the school travel project is finished. This project has been constructed over 2 stages. Stage one dealt with the immediate area around the back gate entry to the school and Stage two was the installation of formalised parking spaces and the addition of a footpath which will allow students to walk safely to school and enter the school grounds.

As part of the design plan there will also be two bus bays created along Hellawell Road, which will have footpath connectivity to make it easier for residents catching the buses at these two locations.
